Narita Airport ⇔ Shimbashi

Airport LIMOUSINE BUS (Narita Airport → Daiichi Hotel Bus Stop [close to venue])



Purchase tickets **online** or at the **Airport Limousine Bus ticket counter** in the airport arrival lobby.

RECEPTION

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

<Weather>

The average temperature in Tokyo in November is between 9°C to 15°C (48°F to 59°F), and average temperature is about 12°C (54°F). It is cool and dry. We suggest wearing layers such as light jackets and sweaters. You may want to bring a folding umbrella in case of rain.

<Time Zone>

Japan standard time (JST), uniform throughout the country, is 9 hours ahead of GMT.

<Currency and Rate of Exchange>

USD\$1.00 = JPY ¥ 149.65 (as of October 13, 2023)

< Telephone country code>

The country phone code to reach Japan is +81

<Electricity>

Electricity service throughout Japan is 100 Volts AC. There are two frequencies in use: 50 Hz in northeastern regions (including Kanagawa and Tokyo) and 60 Hz in the southwestern regions (including Kyoto and Osaka). The plugs used in Japan have two straight pins (**A2 plug**). Participants are advised to check the voltage before using appliances. Some participants may need to bring converters or adapters. (see photo for the Japanese plug)

<Emergencies>

Dial 119 to call an ambulance or fire engine in case of sudden illness or injury, or in case of fire.

Dial 110 to call police in case of traffic accident or crime.

<Tipping>

There is no tipping system in Japan.
